




Albert Einstein was born in Germany in 1879. He became famous as a scientist and as one of the most important thinkers of our times. 








































In 1905 four papers he had written were published in a scientific magazine. All were important. Sixteen years later, one would help to bring him a Nobel Prize.












They ask me what my religion is. I don't believe in dividing people up in such ways.
