


> Yesterday, December 7, 1941, a day that will live in infamy, the United States was attacked by the forces of the Empire of Japan.






When I was eight years old I sailed to China on one of my father's sailing ships!

You get letters from all over the world. Could I start a collection of interesting stamps?









After three years at Groton, he enrolled as a freshman at Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts. It was 1900.
