



WORLD WAR II AND THE COLD WAR




In 1620, it took the Pilgrims more than nine weeks to cross the Atlantic in the *Mayflower*.

Roosevelt and Secretary of State Hull wanted to improve our relations with our Latin American neighbors.

They have had good reason in the past to distrust our intentions. We must convince them that we are no longer "big brother" trying to tell them what to do. In 1934, our Marines were withdrawn from Haiti, ending 19 years of military domination by the United States.]

The United States surrendered the rights of intervention in Haiti and Nicaragua, given it by treaty. In 1936, it surrendered its treaty right to intervene in the Panama Republic.



No state has the right to intervene in the internal or external affairs of another.

At the Pan-American Conference at Montevideo, Secretary Hull approved a new doctrine.




In 1940, the 21 republics of the Inter-American Conference met in Havana.









A constitutional democracy was set up, but was overthrown by the extreme revolutionists, and Vladimir Lenin became premier.



The Bolshevists established a Communist dictatorship and Russia became the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, or the USSR. They proclaimed their intention of promoting worldwide revolution.












But the League was powerless, and Italy took over Ethiopia.


For the protection of the people and the state.
