WHO IS ARIANA GRANDE?

Ariana Grande was born in June 1993. The singer's full name is Ariana Grande-Butera. Her family is of Italian American heritage. She is from Boca Raton, Florida. It is about an hour north of Miami. Ariana's name came from a character named Princess Oriana in *Felix the Cat: The Movie*.

Camila grew up with a sibling too. Her younger sister is Sofia Cabello. Sofia was born in 2007. Like Camila, she enjoys singing. Fans often see the two talk on social media. The sisters sing together, and Camila posts Sofia's pictures. They sometimes perform covers of *High School Musical* songs. On TikTok, Sofia often lip-syncs to Camila's songs.

Ariana told *Billboard* she was “a very weird little girl.” She had her own interests. For example, she liked to wear skeleton face paint even when it wasn’t Halloween. For one birthday, the singer had a *Jaws*-themed party. Her friends were scared of the decorations, she said.
