Teacher's Guide

Genre: Folktales/Legends

DESCRIPTION: Folktales is a collection of tales, ballads, and myths passed from person to person, often in spoken form. As we read from a picture book, folklore comes from the stories we hear, see, and read. Folklore includes oral traditions, songs, and stories. To be considered folklore, these tales must include repeating elements such as talking animals, magic spells, and characters such as "the giant" and "the fairy". Folklore are stories that are only true or based on historic facts. The events in the stories, however, are often exaggerated. The set of books includes folktales from Africa and Europe, as well as a collection of oral folk legends.

Overview of Books

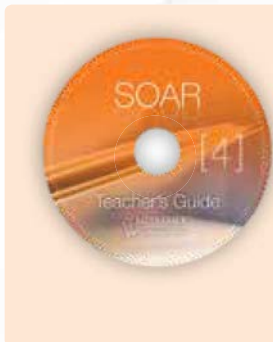

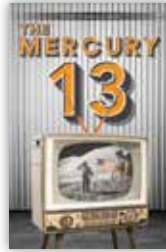
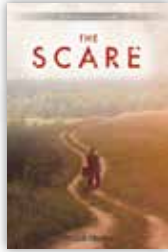

Teacher's Guide

Genre: Classics/Retellings

DESCRIPTION: Includes a collection of folktales and fables from around the world to present value to readers from. An excellent form of popular fiction, folioles contain many of the key elements well understood and recognizable characters and plot devices. Because the stories are to entertain, folioles often include dramatic events and rhetorical devices, such as foreshadowing, foreshadowing, and foreshadowing. These have often include repeating plot elements such as a character who is to be punished for an act (such as "The Boy Who Cried Wolf" and "The Boy Who Cried Wolf"). Legends are stories that are partly true or based on historical events. The events in the legends, however, are exaggerated. This set of stories includes folioles from the past and present, a fair tale from Europe, and a collection account of an old legend.

Overview of Books

Ask students how a foliole is a story passed along from person to person, often in spoken form. Read the first foliole aloud, underlining with an erasable marker any elements of entertainment. Many folioles include basic and heroic characters, exciting events, and foreshadowing elements, such as foreshadowing, foreshadowing, and foreshadowing. Folioles often have satisfying endings in which the main character is said to have "lived happily ever after."

Partner Share: Assign partners and have pairs share any folioles or fairy tales that have read or heard. They will gain to choose one of the folioles stories in this set. Have them describe the kinds of characters and events they might encounter in a book with this title.

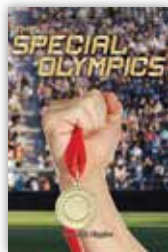
